

From Benecko via Rovinka to Třídolí

Barrier-free route suitable for prams and the disabled

The road starts in Benecko at the Rozcestí car park, it is marked in green, partly without markings and leads to Třídolí on an asphalt surface.

Length: 4.8 km, elevation gain is only 10 m At the crossroads of hiking trails in Rovinky is a pleasant small snack.

Possible route variants:

From the crossroads of the Rovinka hiking trails, it is possible to continue 2 km along the yellow sign to Genoa Mountain, where a herd of 300 Hucul horses graze on extensive pastures reaching up to 1000 m above sea level. There is also a very nice restaurant with a children's playground. The road from Rovinky to Janova hora is asphalt, but the last 400 m to the farm with Hucul horses is with a gravel surface and unevenness, and for wheelchair users this section is almost impassable.

Another option for wheelchair users is the opportunity to set off from Rovinky along the green tourist sign in the direction of Labská u Špindlerova Mlýna. Here you can admire views of the Elbe Dam and Kraus's Huts.

Barrier-free places for refreshments and emergency shelter on the route:

Hotel Kubát: located in Benecko, above the Rozcestí car park, it has a barrier-free restaurant, but wheelchair users will need help to enter - it is necessary to cross 1 step.

Rovinka: a small building with refreshments is located at the end of the route - at a busy crossroads of hiking trails, for wheelchair users is barrier-free only sitting outside with the possibility of food delivery.
