

About the farm

Mountain Farm Hucul is located on the slopes of Janova hora, in the village Vítkovice in the western part of the Giant Mountains. A herd of Hucul horses grazes on 170 hectares of pastures, reaching up to an altitude of 1,100 meters, which ranks among the best Hucul horse breeds in the Czech Republic in terms of the number and quality of breeding mares and stallions.

Services offered by Farma Hucul include horse riding lessons, field trips, children's camps and accommodation.

The farm, surrounded by herds of grazing horses, with a captivating view of the mountain ridges of the Giant Mountains and the valley of the river Jizerka, attracts not only lovers of equestrian art to visit with its rugged beauty and impressive atmosphere.

Types of rides:

field trip with a guide, the minimum duration is half an hour (but we recommend a minimum of 1 hour), including getting on and off, the possibility of two or more hours of rides and a full seven-hour trip. No previous training is required for the ride, even beginners can complete it. Children can ride from the age of 12. The ride is done in a step

trotting and galloping is carried out at an additional cost for advanced riders older than 12 years

leading children - the age limit is not limited, the horse is led by one worker; range from approx. 3 minutes = wheel to an hour in the field.

training in the riding hall - riding lessons for adults and children from 8 years of age are provided in the fenced area of the outdoor riding hall, it is advisable to state when ordering whether you are interested in a riding hall for advanced or beginners

lonž - suitable for children under the age of nine who are not afraid, this training is about the possibility of exercising on the back of a horse with handrails, which the child can hold, or the basics of riding in a riding saddle. The horse is led by one worker on a long bridle and moves in a circle, ie. the child does not have to drive or encourage horses.

A special offer, the so-called family ride, where younger children of 12 years of age are led by employees and parents control the horses themselves, the ride is led in a step, suitable for beginners.

Riding and training is at the riders' own risk. Before riding, riders are equipped with a safety helmet and instructed on the basics of horse control (principles are written and posted).

Opening hours:

horse riding: 9 - 12, 13 - 16 (winter season) - 17 (summer)

The largest number of riders at the same time is 8 + 2 guides.

The price for the ride is paid before it starts. A document (ticket) or receipt is issued for each ride.

Orders:

in person or by phone at 604 245 225. Especially in high season, it is advantageous to book a ride as soon as possible. Start of the ride is best 15 minutes in advance. If the rider does not arrive on time, ie at the agreed hour at the latest, the ride will be forfeited. If the start of the ride is delayed due to the missed riders, the time loss is not compensated or the fare is not reduced.
